## YEAR IN REVIEW

### What we've been up to in 2018

We thought that for the last edition of our Newsletter for the year, we'd bring you an update on some of the many things we've been working on..

- Many **potholes & blocked** drains reported and repaired throughout North Willesborough
- **Litter picks** organised covering Hunter Road Recreation Ground, Orion Way, Joeys Wood, Church Road Recreation Ground, Blake Court and Silver Hill Road.
- **Air Aware Campaign** – monitoring the air quality around Junction 10 and reporting findings to the council
- **Say 'No' to Throwing Plastic Campaign** involving a series of activities including asking local supermarkets to provide plastic free aisles, and encouraging local pubs to use compostable or recyclable straws.
- **Raised £500** for a local Animal Rescue sanctuary by holding a music event at the Windmill Pub.
